

TO FACILITATE COMPARISONS, WE HAVE RATED THEM IN THE AREAS OF PERFORMANCE. DURABILITY, AND COST. THESE RATINGS ARE BASED ON OUR OWN EXPERIENCE IN HANDLING EACH OF THE DIFFERENT MAKES OVER THE YEARS.

ABARTH -

THIS IS THE GRANDDADDY OF THEM ALL, AND WAS FIRST IMPORTED INTO THE USA SHORTLY RETER WORLD WAR II FROM ITALY. THEY PUT OUT A FAIR AMOUNT OF HORSEPOWER, WERE FAIRLY RELIABLE, AND LOOKED AND SOUNDED OREAT, IN FACT, MOST BRANDS THAT HAVE COME OLONG SINCE THEN ARE FAIRLY CLOSE IMITATIONS OF ABARTH.

LINFORTUNATELY, ABARTH'S DISTRIBUTION AND MARKETING PRACTICES IN THIS COUNTRY LEFT SOMETHING TO BE DESIRED, AND ABARTH FINALLY DISAPPEARED FROM THE SCENE.

WARRANTY COVERAGE WAS SOMETHING OF A "CATCH-22" SITUATION. YOU HAD TO FIRST GET FERMISSION TO RETURN A BAD UNIT. THEN PAY FOR THE SHIPPING, AND THEN YOU WERE FULLDITED A PERCENTAGE OF THE PRICE THAT YOU HAD PAID FOR IT. TO BE APPLIED TOWARD A NEW UNIT OF THE SAME TYPE, BASED ON HOW MELLY MILES IT HAD BEEN USED. WHICH HAD TO BE VERIFIED BY AN ABARTH DEALER. IT WAS LOUALLY CHEAPER AND EASIER TO SIMPLY BUY A NEW UNIT.

RUMOR HAS IT THAT ABARTHS STILL FIND THEIR WAY INTO THE COUNTRY FROM .TIME TO TIME, AND YOU COULD DO A LOT WORSE THAN BUY ONE. WE DON'T KNOW WHAT THE CURRENT WARRANTY SITUATION IS.

\*\* PERF-6000 DUR-6000 COST-MED \*\*

THIS BRAND IS ANOTHER ONE OF THE ABARTH COPYS, AND THEY MAKE A UNIT FOR ALMOST EVERY MAKE OF IMPORTED CAR KNOWN TO MAN. THEY ARE INEXPENSIVE, AND LOOK AND SOUND GOOD.

ON THE BAD SIDE. THEY ARE NOTORIOUS FOR RUSTING OUT AND BURNING OUT, AND ALTHOUGH THEY PROVIDE MORE POWER THAN A STOCK MUSFILER SYSTEM, THEY ARE NOT AS GOOD IN THIS DEPARTMENT AS SOME OTHERS. WARRANTY COVERAGE IS OF VERY BRIEF DURATION.

IF YOU BEED A MUFFLER SYSTEM QUICK TO KEEP JOHN LAW OFF YOUR BACK BECAUSE OF MOISE AND DON'T PLAN ON KEEPING THE CAR A LONG TIME. THIS COULD BE A GOOD BUY FOR YOU.

\*\* PERF-FAIR DUR-POOR COST-LOW \*\*

MONZA -

THIS BRAND IS A FAIRLY RECENT ARRIVAL ON THE SCENE, HAVING BEEN INTRODUCED ABOUT FIVE YEARS AGO. MONIA IS NEITHER THE BEST NOR THE WORST. AND COMPARES ROUGHLY WITH ABARTH. ALTHOUGH THE WARRANTY SITUATION IS BETTER (3-YEARS, TOTAL REPLACEMENT). THE SOUND AND APPEARANCE ARE BOTH GOOD, AND THE COST IS REASONABLE.


\*\* PERF-GOOD DUR-GOOD COST-MED \*\*

PRIMA-FLOW-

THIS IS THE NEWEST OF THE EXHAUST SYSTEMS ON THE MARKET, WITH SOME NEW TECHNOLOGY AND HEAVY EMPHASIS ON QUALITY. THEY ARE MADE OF A VERY HEAVY GAUGE OF STEEL. WITH A CERAMIC COATING INSIDE THAT IS BAKED AND CURED TO THE METAL. THE WARRANTY IS LIFSTIME. TOTAL REPLACEMENT.

THE PRIMA FLOW COMPANY CLAIMS HIGHEST PERFORMACE DUTPUT OF ANY BRAND ON THE MARKET. AND BACKS THIS UP WITH CERTIFIED DYNO TESTS. THEY LOOK AND SOLND EXTREMELY GOOD, AND THE NOISE LEVEL IS LOW.

UNFORTUNATELY, PRIMA-FLOW UNITS ARE E-X-P-E-N-S-I-V-E, AND ARE NOT LIKELY TO COME DOWN IN PRICE. IF YOU PLAN ON KEEPING YOUR CAR FOR A LONG TIME AND WANT A REALLY HIGH GUALITY SYSTEM. THIS IS THE ONE.
\*\*\* PERF-HIGH DUR-EXCEL COST-HIGH \*



#### SUPERSPRINT-

THIS BRAND HAS BEEN MADE BOTH IN ITALY AND THE USA, AND THE COMPANYS REPRESENTING THE TWO SOURCES HAVE BEEN EMBROILED IN LEGAL MANEUVERS WITH ONE ANOTHER. IT IS NOW IN THE HANDS OF A NEW DISTRIBUTOR AND MAY BE READY FOR A FRESH START.

SUPERSPRINT IS A HIGH QUALITY SYSTEM WITH GOOD PERFORMANCE. CURRENT WARRANTY COVERAGE IS FOR TWO YEARS. AND DURABILITY IS COMPARABLE WITH STEPRO.

-- PERF-GOOD DUR-GOOD COST-MED

STEBRO HAS A STRANGE HISTORY, HAVING BEEN DISTRIBUTED BY SEVERAL DIFFERENT - CURRENTLY BY ONE BASED IN CANADA. THEY HAVE THO SEPARATE PRODUCT LINES, ONE MADE FROM MILD STEEL AND ONE FROM STAINLESS.

BOTH SYSTEMS HAVE THE SAME PERFORMANCE , BEST FOR THE DIFFERENT CHINERS. AND BOTH HAVE THE SAME GOOD APPEARANCE. THE SOUND IS VERY PLEASING, BUT THE MOISE LEVEL IS DISTINCTIVE - IT'S LOUD! INSERTS ARE OFFERED AT EXTRA COST TO INSTALL IN THE TIP OF THE OUTLET PIPES TO GUIETEN THEM DOWN A BIT.

THE COST AND WARRANTY SITUATION DIVIDE THE THO PRODUCTS, WITH THE MILD STEEL UNITS HAVING A ONE-YEAR WARRANTY AND THE STAINLESS UNITS HAVING A LIFE-TIME WARRANTY (THIS WARRANTY INFO MAY BE DUT OF DATE NOW). THE MILD STEEL UNITS ARE FAIRLY REASONABLE IN PRICE. BUT THE STAINLESS ONES ARE V-E-R-Y E-X-P-E-N-S-I-V-E.

THE STEBRO LINE AS A WHOLE IS A GOOD ONE. AND WE WERE SORRY TO SEE THEM LEAVE THE GOOD 'OL USA.


