MGB PRICES? (As reprinted from MG Magazine)

Now that new MGB body shells are available in England and shortly to be available here, what does that do to the price of MGBs? First, a pristine B (either original or restored) will retain its present value. I know that a restorer can put thousands of dollars into a restoration, but the amount of money put into a car usually does not make the car worth that much. There are some excellent MGBs changing hands for under \$4,000.00; indeed, many are being sold in the \$2,000.00 bracket that I would be proud to own.

These new body shells should have a great impact on the Bs in need of restoration. Any B suffering from much rust damage should be rewarded with a new shell. It just makes good economic sense to do this. That means, of course, that a rusty B will be purchased primarily for parts and identification. I'm convinced that we will be able to find plenty of Bs in this category for \$200-\$500. For how long, I'm not sure. The

line to use when viewing the car is, "This needs a whole new body...it can only be used as a parts car."

These new shells will have separate and distinct serial numbers. I suspect that most restorers will use the identification plates from the car that is being dismantled to identify the "new" car. It will be interesting to see if these rebodied MGBs will be worth the same as a car with an original body. We know that many vintage M.G.s these days have brand new body shells on them, and this does not seem to detract from their value. Regardless of the outcome of that problem, it does appear that many rusted MGBs will have a new life now.

British Motor Heritage is very serious about their body project. True, we won't have new shells in North America by Christmas, but they will come. If you have storage space, better squirrel away a rusty B or two...more if you have several kids and a big barn.
