### Meeting Minutes 11/29/2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 pm by President Harold O'Reilly. Two visitors (potential new members) were introduced: O. J. Williams who was going to pick up his recently purchased cranberry 1974 TR6 and Richard Phillips, who owns a couple of Triumphs, a brown TR2 and TR3.

Old events were discussed; a Taste of Bavaria was attended by the North Shore, South Shore and Baton Rouge members of the club and was well received.

On the election of officers, new officers will be sworn in at the Christmas party. Karen Murray discussed the Christmas party. We were reminded that Coke and Sprite would be provided, but to bring your own adult beverages.


#### Battered Women's Shelter
